GET INFORMED.

Find out the facts about cervical cancer and the human papilloma virus (HPV) that causes it. Help educate other women in your life too.



GET SCREENED.

Cervical cancer screening typically starts at age 30 and is repeated periodically.



GET VACCINATED.

- The HPV vaccine is given in 2 doses that should begin when a girl is between 9 and 14 years old.
- Vaccination against HPV is safe and prevents cervical cancer
